## **I. Recommendation**

Approve the proposed name "Fair Oaks Village Park Community Center" as the official name of the new building outlined in the Village Park, Plaza Park, and Community Clubhouse Master Plan (*Veteran's Memorial Amphitheatre Master Plan*).

## **II. Background**

At the December 16, 2020 Regular Board Meeting, in anticipation of the construction of the Village Park, Plaza Park, and Community Clubhouse Master Plan, the Board of Directors requested staff begin discussions with the Community Resources Development Committee on the naming of the new building. The project originally began as the Veteran's Memorial Amphitheatre Master Plan and was later folded into the overall Village Park, Plaza Park, and Community Clubhouse Master Plan at the April 15, 2020 Regular Board Meeting.

On Thursday, January 14, 2021, staff met with the Community Resources Development Committee (Director O'Farrell & Director Irwin) to discuss the naming of the new building. At the conclusion of the meeting, the recommendation of the committee was to name the building "Fair Oaks Village Park Community Center" to continue the branding of Fair Oaks while also highlighting Village Park as the central location of the facility.

**III. Problem /Situation/ Request**

Staff is requesting the Board of Directors review the recommendation and approve the name of "Fair Oaks Village Park Community Center".

**IV. Financial Analysis**
