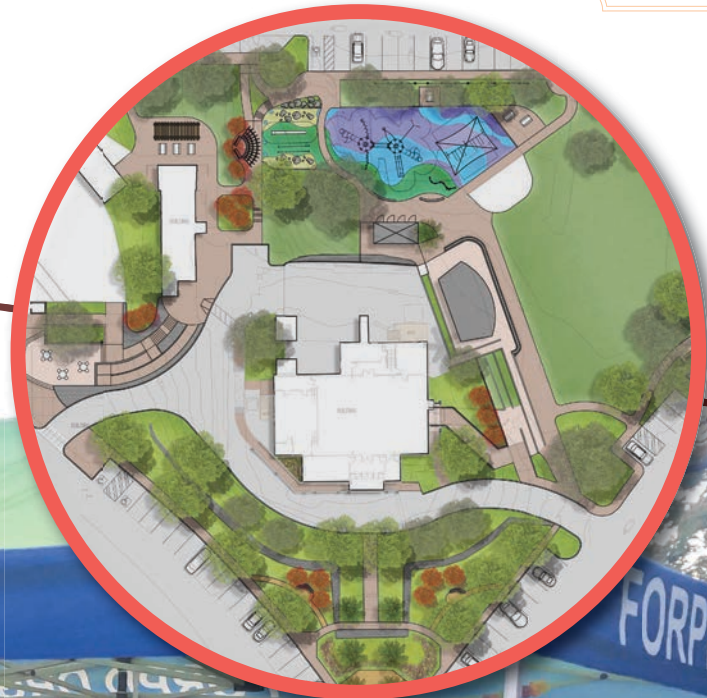

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# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



## OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Village Park Master Plan update is to further the development of the Village Park Master Plan in preparation for the implementation of the improvements as a result of the bond money secured by the passing of Measure J, and to gather data in order to satisfy the requirements of the Prop 68 Grant.

This Amendment serves to document the outreach process and provide guidance for the development of the overall Plaza Park, Village Park and Community Clubhouse Park Complex. Below is a summary of improvements for each area of the park that differ from the 2012 Master Plan:

Plaza Park is primarily used for family recreational activities, leisure walks, picnicking and outdoor festivals. The improvements proposed support the District's desire to expand the schedule of community events for year round use;

- Expanded Plaza Area
- All Weather Surfacing to Support Events
- Reduced Lawn Area under Existing Trees
- Seat Walls/Retaining Walls
- Cafe Seating

The Community Clubhouse hosts a variety of events such as community meetings, club meetings, recreation classes, and special events. Improvements include;

- Native Demonstration Garden Plantings
- Public Art Display Areas

Village Park is a neighborhood park with a large grass area for informal play, a playground, a

bandshell, drinking fountains, and pathways. The bandshell hosts summer concerts and other outdoor events run by the District. The program for this park space does not change but new support amenities will help to support the current uses. Improvements include:

- Assessable Seating Area
- Expanding and Improved Playground
- Hillside Play Area
- New Restroom Building
- New Bandshell and Stage
- Terraced Seat Walls

The Amphitheatre is located between the Plaza Park and the Clubhouse. The Amphitheatre is only open for theater productions in the summer however the new improvements provide an opportunity to bring in additional community events in the current offseason of the theater productions.

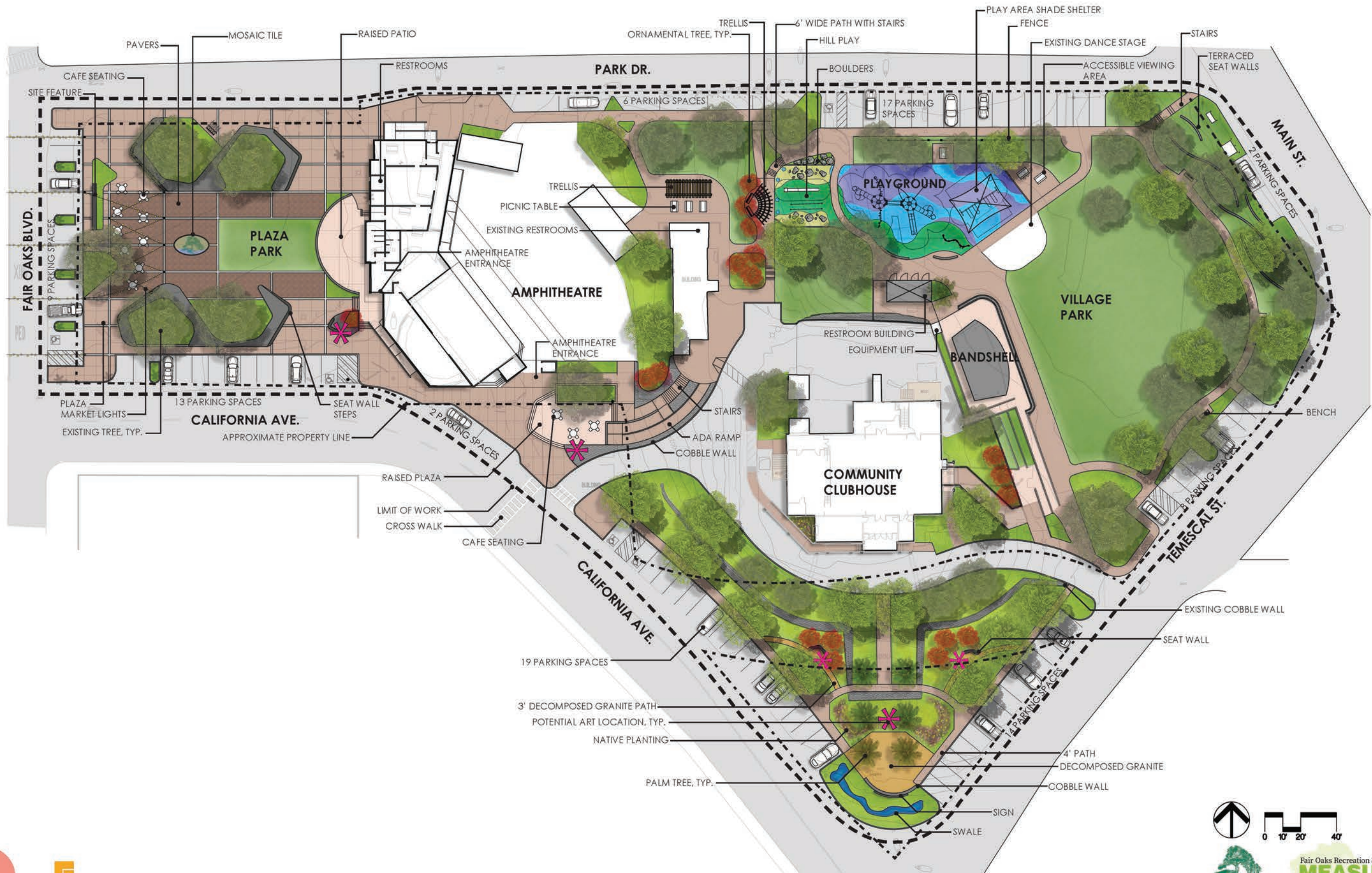
Amphitheatre improvements include;

- Multi Purpose Recreational Room
- Theater Lobby
- Separate Public Restrooms Accessible from the Theater and from Plaza Park
- Additional Storage
- Stage Improvements
- Raised Patio Facing Plaza Park

Other improvements include;

- Removal of the Commercial Building for the creation of a Raised Plaza Space, Stairs and a Ramp to create better accessible links between Plaza Park, the Clubhouse, and the Arts and Craft Building.
- Removal of the Commercial Building allows for additional parking near the Clubhouse and an elongated driveway exit from the Clubhouse to California Avenue.

The purpose of this meeting was to kick off the public input process to validate the Village Park Master Plan completed in 2013 and to revise as needed due to changing needs of the community. The meeting included an introduction to the project and a site walk to receive feedback on the key elements of the master plan improvements prior to moving forward with implementation plans. Callander Associates reviewed all comments received and they will be addressed as required. Discussion items noted below were discussed on our site walk.

### ***Discussion Item***

---

#### **A. Plaza Park**

- More activity for adults such as bocce ball, petanque court, horseshoe court
- More Seating – benches and tables
- Make Park Drive and California Avenue a one-way street (ref. Fair Oaks Village Enhancement Vision Document)
- Traffic calming in front of the pub and on California Avenue for improved safety for pedestrians (crosswalks, speed bumps, speed tables). Could include reducing to a one-way street to allow for sidewalks on both sides.
- Keep the lawn area for frisbee or public events
- Repair surface on Park Avenue
- Instead of a fountain in the plaza put a spray park for the kids.
- Concerned with losing too much plaza space with added parking along park drive.

#### **B. Amphitheatre**

- Most preferred the enclosed stage option with ancillary rooms dedicated to theatre support.
- One person preferred the open/unenclosed main stage with multi-purpose room option, favoring the expansive views of surrounding trees
- Most preferred the bench-style seating for its flexibility; some would prefer softer seats
- Improve access to facility, including access to amphitheatre from west side of park and stage at west side of theatre support building

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C. Restrooms and Craft Room

- Improve drainage
- Not enough stalls in the restrooms, can this be expanded and porta potties removed?
- Improve pedestrian circulation with ADA paths for easy access to the Restrooms.
- More ADA stalls

D. Front of clubhouse renovations

- Add more handicap parking
- Need to leave room for food trucks with future improvements
- Change rose garden to native plants with some art elements
- Eliminate congestion at the drop off area
- Bike parking needed
- More seating, tables and benches
- Keep the plaques (WBA 1940) and cobble wall
- Don't make it contemporary and keep the style of the park.
- The existing parking lot is used for fiesta run staging and the toilet bowl races
- Will traffic be impacted with the off-street parking?

E. Clubhouse

- Just got a new kitchen
- Like the old school charm but some of the building needs to be updated.
- Upgraded lighting?

F. Village Park

- More seating around the park with shade
- During the concerts those with wheel chairs are gathered near the playground. Improve accessibility for them.
- Permeable pavement
- Drinking fountains
- ADA tables and pads for wheel chairs
- Make sure you can still see the playground with the trellis over the kids "dance floor"
- Keep kids "dance floor"
- More shade at Village Park for concerts
- Accessible walkway to restroom's
- Add shade trees
- Could the improvements be modernized?

G. Playground

- Replace sandbox with balance beam or some other play element. The kids love the sand but its messy and ruins the play equipment.
- Additional swings.
- More benches
- Update Play structure
- Splash Pad
- During concert in the park the hill is full with people. If we include a hill slide where will these people go.
- Expand play area
- If expanding the play area, consider moving it for more concern space.
- Shade over play area

The District and design team met with community members during the public input process for the playground at Village Park and overall Master Plan improvements. The workshop hosted well over 60 kids and adults throughout the course of 1 ½ hours. At the event kids were given a passport to be stamped at 4 stations: Design, Imagine, Create and Assemble. A fully stamped passport allowed the kids to enjoy ice cream after the event out at the bandshell. The District and design team facilitated each station and encouraged kids to participate in the interactive exercises that included: voting on preferred play elements, a virtual tour of a preferred playground, drawing a playground, and browsing through play catalogs to select their favorite play equipment. At the Parents Corner notes were taken that addressed the parent's comments and concerns on the play area or overall Master Plan. The input received will provide direction for the development of the playground at Village Park and Master Plan Improvements. See *attachment D for workshop images*.

## Discussion Item

**A. Design Station:** Displayed at this station there were five (5) boards of different independent play features. These features included spin, hill play, swing, climb and bounce. The kids were given two (2) pompoms to vote on their preferred play features. See *attachment A for images boards*. The final votes were tallied at the end of the workshop, see below.

- Spin = 23
- Hill Play = 21
- Bounce = 13
- Climb = 12
- Swing = 11

The kids were most excited about play features that spin and utilize a hillside slope. These features will be considered in the final playground design.

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### Discussion Item

---

- B. Imagine Station:** Kids were given the opportunity to select from three (3) different playground layouts to view in virtual reality. They were shown a 3D model of the different options then given the VR goggles to view their preferred concept. Kids were excited to see the playgrounds through the VR goggles and enjoyed different features from each playground such as: ziplines, towers and net play. Refer *attachment B for images*.
- C. Create Station:** The kids were given a choice between: a blank playground page where they could draw their ultimate Village Park playground or; one of the preferred plans of playground layouts, that they viewed in VR, to color. Some of the popular items seen in the kids' drawings include: water features, slides, swings, a zip line and a spinning element. See *attachment C for kids drawings*.
- D. Assemble Station:** Displayed at this station were a variety of play catalogs and materials included in playground construction. Parents and kids had the opportunity to browse catalogs and bookmark preferred play elements. Popular catalog items include: large play towers, musical elements and net play.
- E. Parent's Corner:** Notes were taken at the parent's corner that addressed the comments and concerns of parents for the play area and the overall master plan improvements. Below is a summary of the notes taken at the parent's station.
1. Play Area Improvements
    - Kid friendly pollinator garden
    - Refer to magical bridge playground as an example
    - Provide musical play items
    - Keep swings for older kids or adults
    - Provide shade
    - Theme of the playground could be a chicken theme (nesting boxes or chicken décor)
    - Rope climbing element
    - Zip line
    - Curvy slide
    - Teeter totter or low bridge that moves
    - Comfortable spot for moms and dads with shade
    - Treehouse theme for playground
    - Small kids play area separate from big kids area
    - Modern merry-go-round
    - Rubber surfacing
    - Environmentally friendly playground (no poisonous products and use recycled materials)
  2. Safety Improvements
    - Keep fencing and add a gate at play area
    - Enclose high areas, such as tall slides, so kids can't lean over
    - Latex free surface at playground

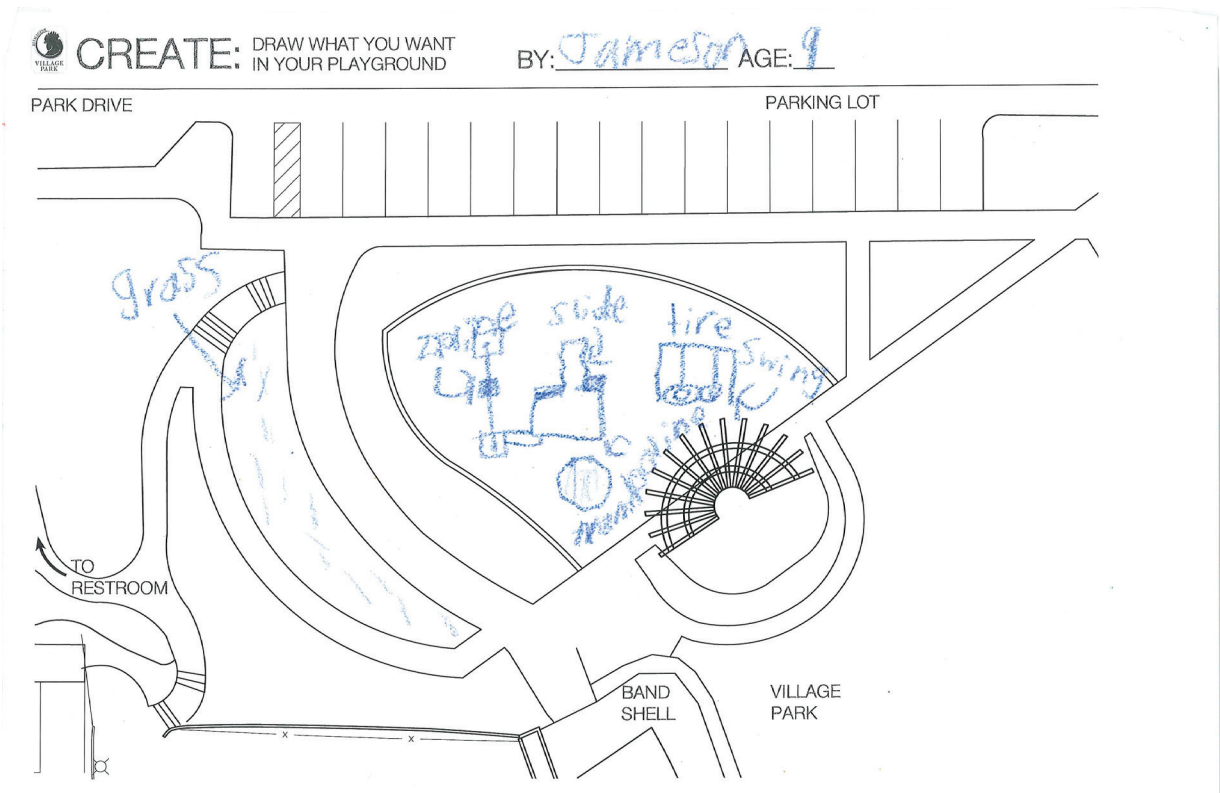

Date: Thursday June 6, 2019

Time: 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Attendees: See attached Sign in Sheet

The District and design team met with community members for the public input process for the Village Park Master Plan improvements. The workshop hosted over 40 patrons at the outdoor dining space of the Fair Oaks Brew Pub. The event consisted of an open house style display, a presentation and an interactive polling of some specific questions about the master plan. The input received will provide direction for the refinement of the Master Plan. Input received from the interactive polling is included as Attachment A. A summary of the results and additional comments is listed below. See attachment B for workshop images.

## ***Discussion Item***

---

### **1. Question: What is your Favorite Local Event?**

We heard from patrons that they enjoy the events at the park but some support amenities would be helpful to improve the function of the events. Ideas included, better seating options, shade at Village Park, and a stage.

- a. 42% responded with the Chicken Festival
- b. 23% responded with Concerts in the Park
- c. 19% responded with Christmas in the Village

### **2. Question: What is your favorite activity at the park?**

The word cloud generated words of varying sizes. The larger the text, the more often the word was mentioned. The results help in understanding why people come to the park.

- a. Concerts generated the largest text.
- b. People enjoy using the park to listen to music, walk their dog, watch their children at the playground, watch the Chickens, and check out other events like the Comedy under the Stars.

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**3. Question: What area of the park needs the most improvement?**

The areas selected helped to inform the design team as to what areas of concern should be focused on for further analysis.

- a. 38% selected Plaza Park as needing the most improvement
- b. 17% selected the Amphitheatre and Parking at the Clubhouse
- c. 13% selected the Playground
- d. 8% selected Village Park and the Clubhouse

**4. Question: Many new park amenities were suggested to be included in the Master Plan during the site walk. Would you like to see new amenities at the park?**

The original master plan had minimal new park amenities and at the time, the community did not support much change to the parks. The results confirm that the community is more interested in adding some new park amenities.

- a. 92% responded with yes

**5. Question: If you would like new park amenities, what would you want added?**

This generated a word cloud similar to question 2. Results help with direction on what to consider for new amenities. Bocce ball was mentioned a couple of times but some folks from the audience were concerned about adding them since new courts were going to be installed at a nearby restaurant. Other responses listed below will be explored with the District for feasibility of incorporation into the Master Plan.

- a. Music, Seating, Bike racks, water feature, acoustic stage were some of the most frequent responses.

**6. Question: Which Amphitheater Option do you prefer?**

The audience was concerned with the cost difference between the two options. Tim from WMB confirmed that Option B was 30% more expensive. Even with that cost difference, the majority of the audience preferred Option B. Comments included making sure that the mural was salvaged and consider looking at the architecture style to relate more with the Village. CALA to work with WMB and District on refining this concept for the Master Plan.

- a. 65% would like option B (Blackbox Stage w/ Retractable Doors, backstage and Dressing Rooms)

**7. Question: What community activity would you most like to see in the Amphitheater during the off-season?**

Many comments from the audience were to have more performing arts events and black box theater performances during the offseason. CALA and WMB to confirm with the District their intent on potential programming of the space and to verify the design can accommodate the programming.





- a. 52% of the responses were for performing arts events
  - b. 17% were for Children's Classes
  - c. 17% were for other. Some suggestions included indoor recreation such as kick boxing.
- 8. Question: What garden style do you prefer for the clubhouse?**  
The audience was vocal about not wanting roses because of maintenance and water use.
- a. 100% were in support of a low water use garden.
- 9. Question: What water feature do you prefer at Plaza Park?**  
The original master plan called for a traditional fountain at Plaza Park. At the site walk, we received comments about wanting other water features or spray pads at the park. It was communicated that the District will evaluate the long term costs of a water feature but if one was afforded, the majority of people wanted a plaza style, interactive water jets
- a. 45% wanted the plaza style, interactive water jets
  - b. 29% were not in support of a water feature
- 10. Based on the input CALA will proceed with developing alternatives that incorporate what we have heard. This will be presented to the Board for feedback prior to moving forward with the design.**

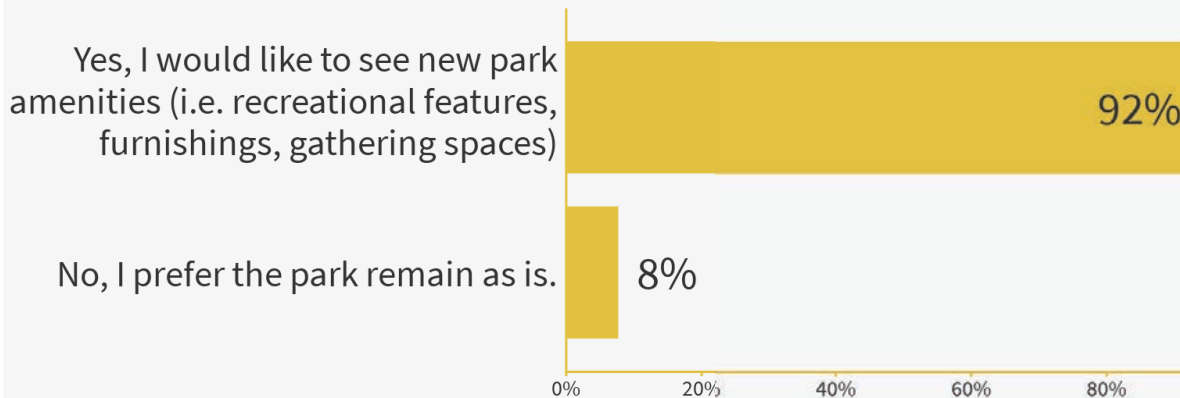

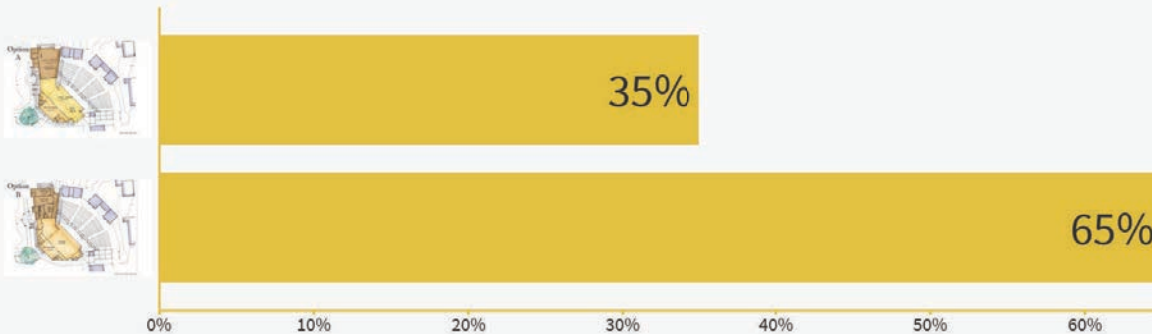

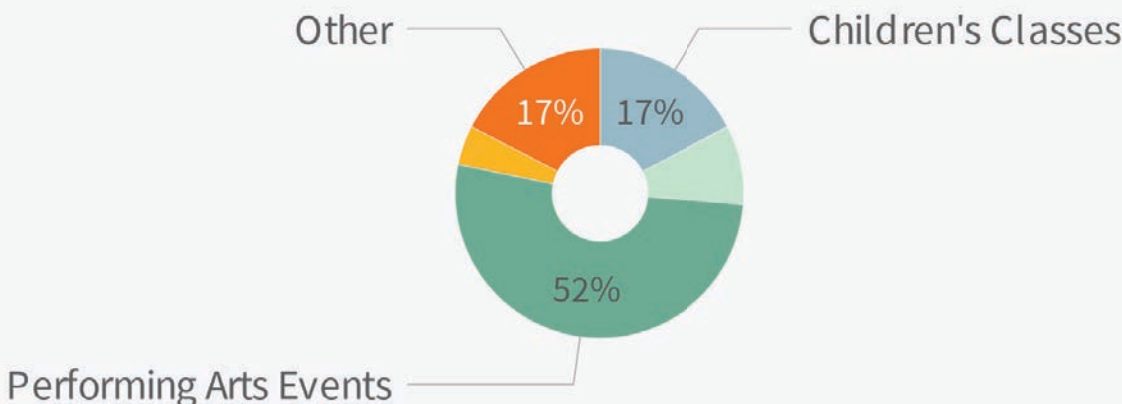

# What community activity would you most like to see in the Amphitheater during the theater's off-season?

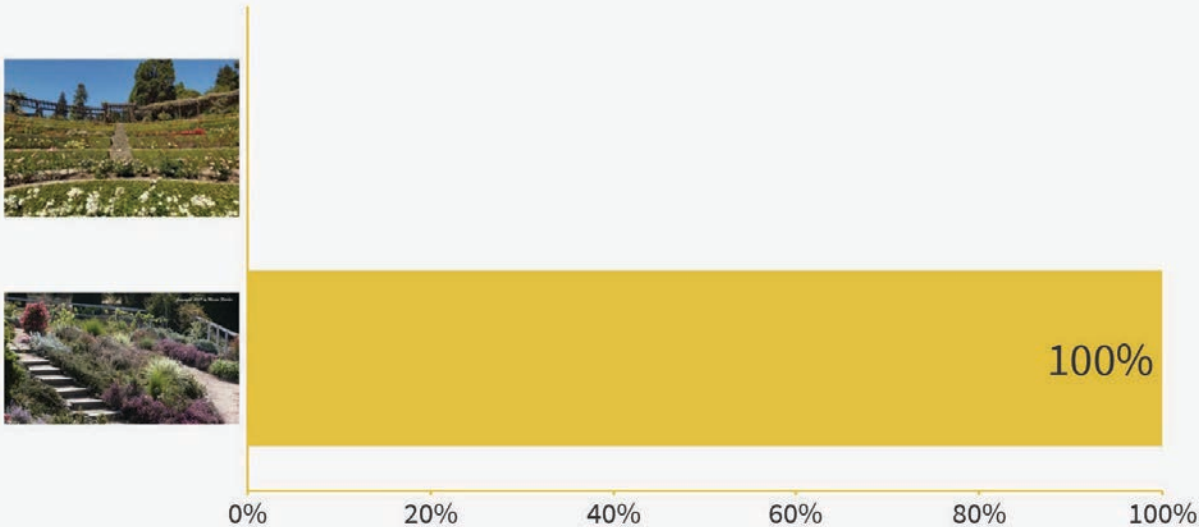

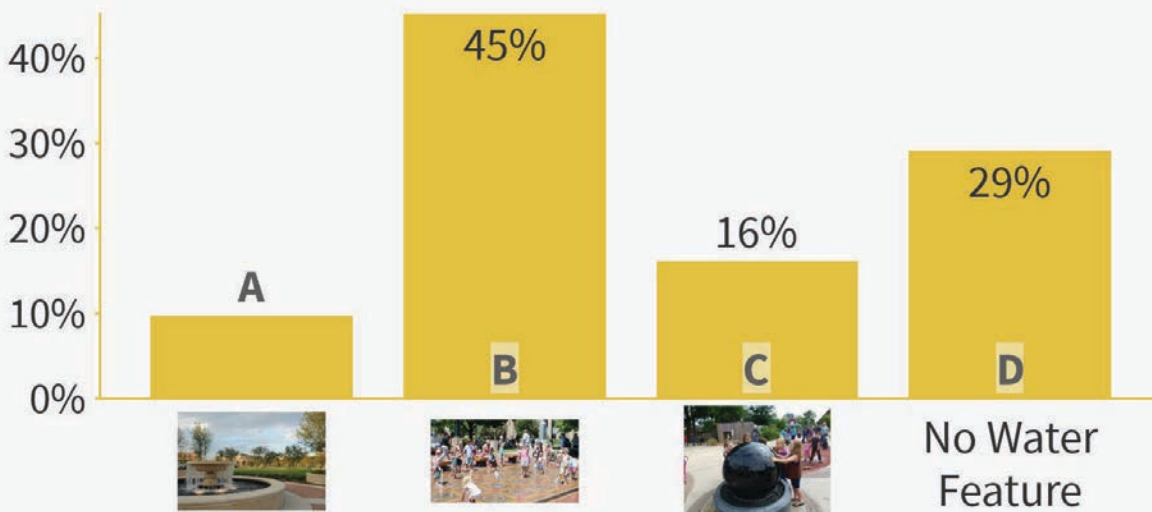
# Which garden style do you prefer for the Clubhouse?

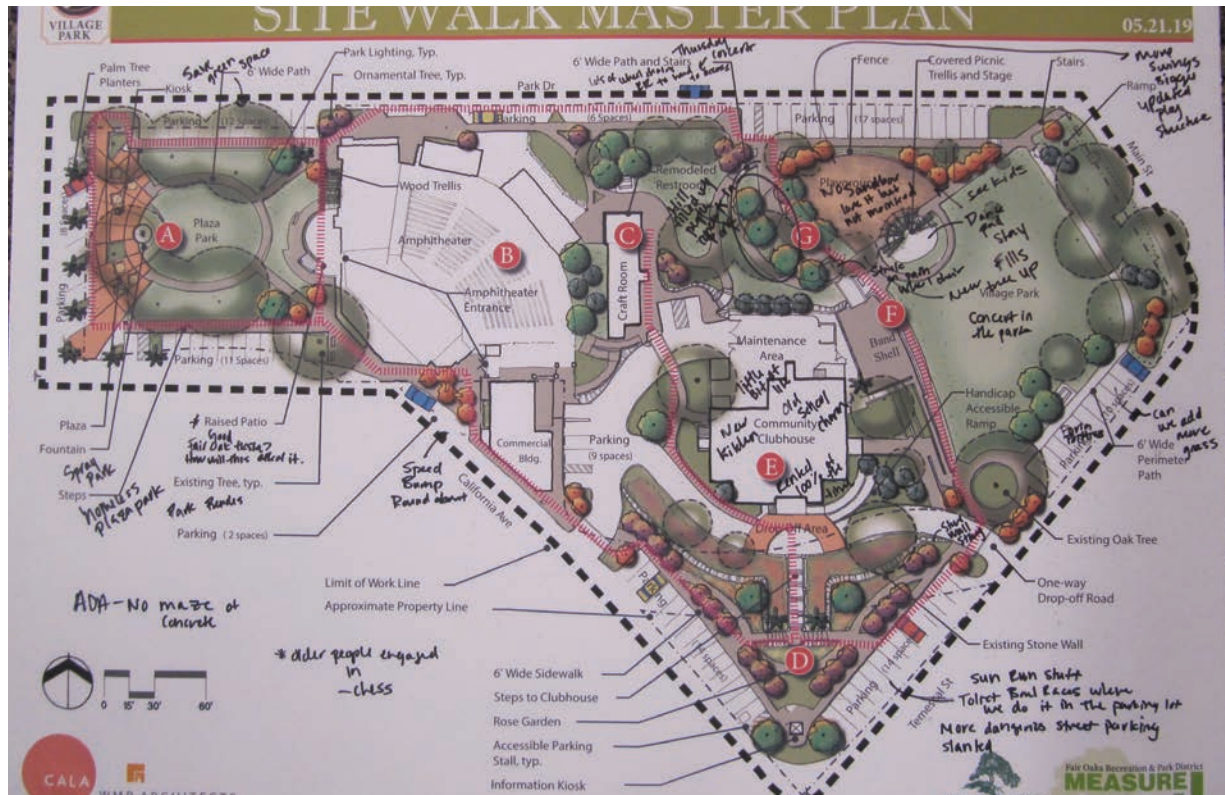
