

In November 2018 residents of Fair Oaks Recreation & Park District (FORPD) passed Measure J, a \$26.9 Million Dollar General Obligation Bond which will help fund major projects that will improve and expand the services provided by FORPD.

Construction Updates



Village / Plaza Renovations

We're in an exciting point in the construction process! You may have seen as you travel through the village that the foundation pad for the amphitheater building has been poured, the two (2) 70-foot steel beams have been installed to support the amphitheater stage roof, and framing has begun on the theater building. District staff is thrilled to watch as the building rapidly takes shape in the capable hands of Bobo Construction's team.

In other areas of the project site progress continues despite the delays brought about by rain. Electrical conduits have been run for site lighting, water connections for the amphitheater have been moved and reconnect as per Fair Oaks Water District's specifications, the District continues to work with PG&E for gas connections to the amphitheater and with SMUD to move electrical lines throughout the site for increased redundancies in area connections and to provide service to new and existing buildings within the project site.

Work continues on re-roofing a storage building outside of the Clubhouse, gutting the old restrooms in Village Park to convert them to additional storage buildings (don't worry – there are additional restrooms being installed in both sides of the property), and grading the remainder of the site in preparation for further construction tasks.

Workers are still hard at it inside the Community Clubhouse as well. The renovated restrooms in Village Hall, the lower level of the Clubhouse, are progressing. Plumbing, electrical and carpentry have all been roughed in. In the Community Clubhouse Auditorium restrooms, plumbing, electrical and carpentry have likewise all been roughed in. Throughout the Community Clubhouse Auditorium workers continue to run electrical lines and HVAC ducting. And the District is investigating water leaks found in the lower level of the Clubhouse building and planning mitigation measures to future-proof the building against weather-related damages.

Don't forget to come visit the village to see for yourself! Three separate nose-in parking sections have been completed and opened to the public.
